Your Reference List should appear at the end of your paper. Each source you cite in the paper must appear in the reference list. Your references should begin on a new page. Label this page References (with no quotation marks or underlining). **The references should be double-spaced.** The information here has been based on the 5th edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association.

Unpublished interviews are cited in the text, but NOT in the References (because they do not provide recoverable data).

Include the name of the person interviewed, and write personal communication and date within parenthesis.

- if the date when the information was posted or last updated is available, include it immediately after the author in parenthesis. If no date is available, use n.d..(no date).
- when an author is not identified, begin the reference with the title of the document.
- titles of websites should be italicized, with only the first word of the title, subtitles, and proper nouns capitalized.
- There is no period at the end of the reference when the reference ends with an internet address.
